As Founder and present Chairman, I have taken upon myself to make the following decisions on behalf of the Club which was conveyed to those present at the AGM.

1. The Club will continue to hold its weekly coffee morning at 10am at Seamoor Wine Bar every Wed.
2. The present balance - money in the bank is £192.44
3. To suspend the membership fees as of the present and until the club has a budget to see how much money we need to run the club and what the money will be spent on.
4. In the course of the next two weeks, it is hopeful that the club will find a secretary to fill this role in accordance to the club constitution.
5. Further activities will be introduced within the Social Club to be taken place within the harbour such as once a month "Communal Lunch Get-together " which will be open to members and non-members of the social club living within Sovereign Harbour. Simply Italian Restaurant Management are interested to offer our Club Members Buffet Lunches based each month on various themes.
6. In addition there will be organised social bingo, short mat bowling, afternoon line dancing, cards and games get-togethers which will provide an opportunity to meet opponent or partner to play favourite games.
7. Simply Italian Restaurant Management are willing to help by offering our social club the use of the restaurant annex mid-week between 10am and 11.30am and in the afternoon between 2.30pm and 4.30pm. This will be in addition to hopefully use other facilities providers in the harbour.
8. Speakers will be kept to once a month but none in the month of December.
9. Finally, the new Mayor of Eastbourne is keen to meet and greet the residents of Sovereign Harbour through the Harbour Social Club.

I have extended an invitation which was accepted, for the Mayor to visit our Social Club on Wed. the 16th of June at 10am to have coffee with members.

Any resident of the harbour whether member of our social club or not, is welcome to come along and shake hand with the New Mayor.
